This month we worked on incorporating the skills of listening, following instructions, asking questions and sharing into one great activity. The activity the class participated in was trying to figure out a map of the room and re-arranging their own desks according to the map. The students had to look at the map and following a certain set of instructions. Those instructions were:

1. They were not able to talk unless asking the teacher a question.
2. Each student was allowed to ask the teacher one question and the teacher kept track.
3. Students had to listen to each other when answers to questions were given.
4. Students had to share their skills of working together and communicating with non-verbals.
