SCRIP NEWS - SHELL LOCAL DEALERSHIP CARDS

Just a reminder that the SHELL cards that we now carry in the box are able to be used at ANY Shell station in Wisconsin and Upper Michigan. These cards are offered to our SCRIP program with a 10% rebate (that gives you 9% for tuition credit).

In addition, Shell offers the Shell Fuel Rewards program that you might want to register for. The Rewards program provides customers with a minimum of 5 cents/gallon off the street price of gasoline. During the Big Ten season, there is an additional promotion to take advantage of; Big Ten Tuesday offers 10 cents off per gallon.

If you are placing your SCRIP order on-line, be sure to select the **SHELL-LOCAL DEALER** card (no logo @ 10% rebate) and not the Shell (corporate logo @ 1.5% rebate).
